New Generation of Disclaimers with CodeTwo

Support for the messages sent internally within the Exchange organization, a brand new HTML editor, ability to create signatures/disclaimers in multilingual versions, an enhanced integration with Active Directory make up the new functionalities of CodeTwo Exchange Rules. The application in version 3.0 has been released today.

*"Codewo Exchange Rules 3.0 has been thoroughly tested and is now ready," says **Michał Bednarz**, the founder of **CodeTwo**, who is the only specialist in Poland to hold the title of **Microsoft MVP for Microsoft Outlook**. "The testing of this enhanced version of the disclaimer software was conducted by in-house experts in this field. The application was also tested by selected clients. In developing the new solution we have taken into consideration all their suggestions and proposals."*

The users of CodeTwo Exchange Rules 3.0 have a set of new functionalities for their disposal that make the composition, edition and management of footers a simple task. The program in its new release is capable of handling internal mail. Therefore all messages that are sent between the Exchange servers of the organization or within its single server will receive signatures/disclaimers centrally as well. In the previous releases the program was only capable of adding footers to outbound mail i.e. external.

The administrators of electronic mail will surely find the new HTML editor helpful. The editor used in the old versions was an outsourced component, and it contained several shortcomings e.g. it unsatisfactorily supported signatures that included national characters from languages other than Western. The editor in version 3.0, engineered by CodeTwo programmers, enables editing signatures with non-standard characters as well as fool-proof processing of messages composed in various international encodings. Now a user of CodeTwo Exchange Rules can be sure that the footer will always display correctly on the recipient's machine.

*"One of the key improvements in the new version involves the access to Active Directory, which stores personal data of the senders such as first name, last name, company branch, business name, e-mail address, telephone number," explains **Michał Bednarz**. "These changes will surely be welcomed by administrators who compose footer templates based on Active Directory fields. v3.0 expands the user attributes that can be used in the signature template formation."*

A customer survey conducted by CodeTwo company shows the application is highly valued by customers for functionalities and reliability. The surveyed businesses emphasize the program's positive impact on document circulation in the company. CodeTwo Exchange Rules streamlines document management workflow, unifies the format of company mail, as well as helps employees save time otherwise spent on manual addition of signatures. This is done centrally on the server by the administrator.

*"The users of CodeTwo Exchange Rules stress that the program is a considerable aid in making electronic company mail compliant with the current legal requirements," says **Michał Bednarz**. "The Commercial Companies Code institutes the legal obligation to include in electronic mail the information on the company such as company type, its registered office, tax identification data, initial capital, and etc."*

Thus the maintenance of uniform signatures/disclaimers becomes a must. This explains the demand for applications such as CodeTwo Exchange Rules.”

The program is capable of adding uniform signatures/disclaimers not only to the messages sent using Microsoft Outlook. The solution engineered by CodeTwo is compatible with mail clients: OWA, OMA, BlackBerry etc. In addition, CodeTwo Exchange Rules includes tools for archiving and keeping statistics of all company mail processed by Exchange Server.
