Professional signature, disclaimer and branding software for Exchange Server 2000/2003 updated

An updated version of CodeTwo Exchange Rules 2003 has been released by CodeTwo last week. The program is one of the market-leading solutions designed for adding signatures, disclaimers and email banners to incoming and outgoing emails sent via Exchange Server 2000 and 2003.

CodeTwo software is definitely one of the leading solutions designed for appending signatures and disclaimers to Exchange mail and its improved version for Exchange Server 2000/2003 has just been released.

Although the era of older Exchange Server editions seems to be fading, numerous companies are still using them for hosting their corporate mail. Therefore, it's definitely good news for those organizations that their signature/disclaimer software is still being developed.

CodeTwo Exchange Rules 2003 allows server administrators to create server-sided signature and disclaimer rules. Owing to the program, there is no need to manage the mail signatures on each of the mail clients individually. The signatures are designed by the administrator in a convenient HTML editor and attached to messages directly on the server, according to the Active Directory criteria he or she has chosen. This helps to keep a unified and professional view of corporate mail and in the end enhances the visual identity of the company as a whole. Additionally, it often happens that due to legal regulations, business emails must contain legal footnotes under the body of the message. Therefore, CodeTwo Exchange Rules 2003 not only makes company emails look better but also frequently helps organizations to fulfill strict legal requirements or even avoid lawsuits.
